Technology Project

As part of your Biography Fair assignment, you will complete a technology project. This project can be completed at home or at school. Depending on the technology you choose to use, you may have time to work on it during your assigned computer lab time.

Your technology project will answer the question:

What "footprint" has this individual left on our society?

To answer this question, you will need to think critically about your Biography Fair individual. You are **NOT** to simply restate the facts you have learned about this individual (for example, when and where they were born, where they studied, who they married, etc.) Instead, you will need to **make inferences** and **draw conclusions** about this person based on what you have learned.

Step One

Think about the **character traits** that this individual demonstrated in his or her life. What can we learn from the way they lived their life? Complete the <u>Character Traits Planning Sheet</u> with a description of these character traits and specific examples of how this famous person demonstrated those character traits through their actions.

Step Two

Think about and analyze this person's contributions to our world. On the <u>Contributions to Our World Planning Sheet</u>, apply your knowledge of this person's decisions, actions, obstacles they overcame, and character traits to decide what **life lessons** we can learn from this person.

Step Three

Choose the **technology** you will use to share this information. Some of these options are technologies that we have not used together in class this year. You should choose a technology that you are interested in and willing to put effort into learning how it works. This might involve experimenting with the program to learn what it can do before you begin your project. You will need to submit the <u>Parent Permission Slip</u> after deciding which technology you will use.

Step Four

Plan your technology project on your <u>Planning Sheet</u>. All planning will be complete before you even open the program. Your plan must be approved by your teacher before you can begin working in your technology program. This is to help make sure you are creating quality work that will meet all the expectations of the project.
